1. **Membership**

Only a few "hiccups" with the handover and membership renewal. Paper option on HR Intranet to be kept as an option for renewal. To date 136 members have rejoined/joined. 40 EA payments. Jeremy Barber and David Gould did not receive first time renewal email. Membership cards available to be printed off by member when renewing on line. Several incomplete renewals to rectify.

2. **Treasure's Report**

Balance £4,854. £2,430 from membership. £581 from Solent Half Marathon entries. Money spent on 2 coaching courses, £690 on kit, £293 on Ryde 10M and X/C event. £117 on kit sold and £150 on clock hire.

3. **Coaching**

Steve Henry reported that he was half way through his coaching course before being assessed. Coaches have now introduced track sessions (300 metre track at Applemore College). Kim Cotton now involved in beginners sessions. Several Tuesday night training sessions have now included ladies from the beginners course (members to be reminded to make them welcome as they could be nervous about joining this group). With the Forestry Commission logging taking place, training has proved difficult within the Dibden Inclosure.

4. **Club Kit**

Marilyn reported that the move of the club kit from Applemore to Ian Hawker's shop "The Bed Shop", Marsh Parade, Hythe a success, with £296 worth of kit sold since the move. Vests £15, T-shirts £17. Old stock to sell off at a reasonable price (see post minute note).

5. **Hants Road Race League**

Solent Half Marathon (9 October) accepted into the League for 2016/17 (11 races). No Lordshill 10M this season, but the Hayling Island 10 admitted. 60 runners overall took part in the 2016/16 league. Results and awards available on the HR website.

6. **CC6**

New clubs added to league this season. Car parking still a problem and it was agreed that car sharing should always be encouraged. For our own event it was agreed that Oak Road car part should be used for cars carrying a single person. Kick off meeting for the 2016/2017 season to be held in August.

7. **RR10**

A big thank you from Steve for a great turn out from Hardley for our event and he reported that the Romsey RR who fell at the finish funnel was now ok. The male/female ratio of the overall. participants was now 50/50. Overall for the season 32 members represented the club and 19 ladies. Finishing positions 12th men, 7th ladies.

8. **Cross Country**
