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### **1. Membership**

Membership renewals have so far gone through fairly smoothly with the new arrangements, though we have lost Mike Callus who decided not to renew his membership due to the changes. Two other members (Kevin Hancock and Susan Massey) have resigned for other reasons.

At last count we have 101 full, 15 non-competitive, 4 out of county, 10 EA registered 2nd claim, and 5 social members - 135 in total.

There have been a few issues with people not being able to pay online for some reason, and a couple of problems with paypal which are being/have been rectified.

A small handful of people still prefer to pay by cheque, or have asked me for an alternative if they've run into problems with paysubs, though these have been renewing members and not new. I think taking off the postal membership form option was mentioned previously? So think this would be ok with just a mention of contacting me if anyone prefers a non-electronic payment method.

### **2. Treasurer's Report**

We currently have £3,884 in the bank, which is £2,086 less than the £5,970 we finished 2017 on. However, we do currently have £2,346 in our PayPal account waiting to be transferred. This will bring the total balance to £6,230.

We also have a second reserve account of £1,595 (no movement from the end of 2017).

#### **Membership Income v Running Expenses**

##### **Income**

Total membership fees are currently on £3,298, which is £559 less than the £3857 we generated throughout the whole of 2017. Therefore, just another 19 £30 sign-ups will bring our 2018 fee income level with the total we saw for 2017.

Other significant income includes £291 on kit, £240 on the clock and £381 on the Solent half (which includes a £90 donation and £252 back transfer from UK Athletics)

**TOTAL INCOME (so far for 2018): £4,210**

#### Running Costs

Affiliation fees totalled £1,977 (including EA subs) This figure also includes ARC, RR10, shower facilities at Applemore Rec and the Holbury track during the summer.

#### Kit

We purchased vests and T shirts to the value of £457 which arrived last week. I need to catch up with Marilyn to put together an updated stock check.

#### Training

Dan Chown and Simon Ibbotson took the Run Leader training course which cost a combined £307 including travel. Chris Harris also claimed £34 of travel costs for a workshop she attended in Guildford. (£341 total)

#### Solent Half

Two 2017 cheques were cashed late resulting in £282 outlay in January. Since then we have also spent a further £147 for the StuWeb timing and a £50 donation to Hammy for photos. (£479 total)

Other expenditure of £695 includes:

- £280 on four CC6 medical WEMS
- £100 garage rental
- £86 Ryde 10 Mile Ferry
- £76 to Fawley Parish Council for use of QE rec
- £48 for the Lepe barbecue social
- £26 X/C transport expenses

**TOTAL EXPENDITURE (so far for 2018): £3,950**
